SOUTHEAST CONNECTOR DESIGN-BUILD PROJECT QUALIFICATIONS SUBMITTAL INSTRUCTIONS

South-Point Constructors (SPC) is seeking to engage with local, small, and diverse firms who are interested in performing Environmental Engineering services on the SE Connector Design Build Project. In the coming weeks, we will be working diligently to identify DBE firms whose qualifications and capabilities align with immediate design phase opportunities. We have assembled the following instructions to assist firms in preparing to submit qualifications.

ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEERING SUBCONSULTANT EVALUATION & SELECTION PROCESS OVERVIEW

1 Set up an account in BuildingConnected to access design package documents:

- Visit <https://app.buildingconnected.com/createaccount> to set up an account.
- Click [here](#) to access the SPC bid page, and click “Join” button to access desired scope documents.

2 Complete the [Qualifications Submittal Form](#) and upload required supporting documents (qualifications statements, certification documents, etc.). **Qualifications Forms should be completed and submitted no later than April 1, 2022, 4pm CDT.**

- Please be sure to access form from a computer (not a mobile device) and plan for approximately 45 minutes to complete.
- Prior to starting Qualifications Submittal Form, please have the following electronic documents on hand:
 - » DBE Certification documents
 - » Certificate of Insurance
 - » Company brochure, capabilities statement, etc. (Optional)
 - » Resumes of key personnel proposed
 - » Client Contact information for project references (name, organization, title, email, phone)
- **Be prepared to provide the following to demonstrate firm’s Qualifications and Relevant Experience.** In the corresponding field in the Qualifications Submittal form, please type (or copy and paste) the following:
 - » **Firm’s Structure and Project Approach** – (Please provide a brief summary of firm’s organizational structure, understanding of the project issues and approach to the project.
 - Describe how the project will be performed from Design to Completion; any firm specific tools that will be used on the project; and Describe any significant project issues

and the firm’s approach to addressing those issues. The understanding of the project issues and approach to the project shall be tailored to delivering the package as discussed in the Scope Package Detail documents.

- Provide detail of firm’s qualifications, as well as aspects of the firm that will benefit if selected.

» **Experience and Availability of Proposed Staff** – Firm must have adequate and experienced current staff (including professionals registered in applicable fields, other professionals, and technicians) to effectively perform the work.

- Identify proposed project leadership and reporting responsibilities.
- List the location of the offices proposed to work on the project as well as contact information and who is to be the sole agent for contact with the SPC for this project.
- For each proposed staff member, please provide the following: Employee name, proposed role/list of proposed functions on project, years of experience, relevant licenses/certifications, 3-5 sentence experience summary.
- Please upload resumes of each proposed staff member in Required Documents section (at end of form).

» **Project Experience** – Please provide a brief description of the firm’s history and success with projects of similar programs, budgets, and/or clients as the project described in this solicitation.

- Provide two (2) relevant example projects completed in the past five (5) years. In addition, SPC may consider firms’ history in complying with project programs, schedules, and budgets on previous projects with SPC member firms (Kiewit, Austin, AECOM), or relevant project experience within TXDOT.

- Upon completion of the form, select option to “Send copy of my responses” to receive a system generated email copy of your submittal.

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- 3 Shortlist process: All Qualifications forms submitted by April 1, 2022 at 4pm CDT will be reviewed by SPC design discipline leads. Firms with **complete** submittals that most strongly demonstrate an understanding of the work, relevant experience and capabilities, and the ability to meet staffing requirements will be shortlisted.
 - Documentation of design project completion on time and within budget;
 - Quality of previous project work completed, including references from past project owners (clients);
 - Ability to start when required; and
 - Ability to meet project requirements (insurance coverage, safety, quality)
- 4 Shortlisted firms will be notified via email by April 8, 2022 and invited to interview with SPC design leadership team.
 - Interviews are currently scheduled to take place during the week of April 11, 2022 between the hours of 8am and 6pm CDT.
 - Interviews will be scheduled in 30-minute blocks, consisting of 15 min presentation and 15 min Q&A. (Additional instructions will be provided upon shortlist notification)
 - Please come prepared to discuss your firm's qualifications and capabilities.
- 5 During the interview, firms will be assessed according to the following criteria (based on information provided in subcontractor questionnaire, qualifications submitted, presentation, and interview responses):
 - Understanding of project and approach to work
 - Ability to provide the number of qualified personnel to complete the required tasks on time.
 - Possess the requisite licenses for both the firm and personnel to authorize participation;
- 6 Firms selected by SPC to perform subconsultant services on the project will be notified during the week of April 18, 2022 to negotiate scope, schedule of values, terms, conditions, and price.
- 7 Debriefs will be provided to firms not selected upon written request submitted (within 45 days) to: Outreach@SouthPointConstructors.com.
